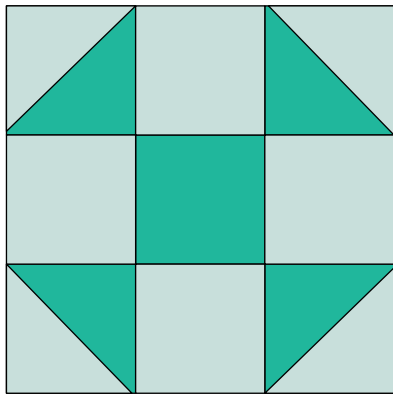


The Block : “Shoofly”

9” finished - 9 1/2” unfinished



The Requirements:

2 or 3 colours of fabric - Main colour and Background colour (centre square can be a contrast)

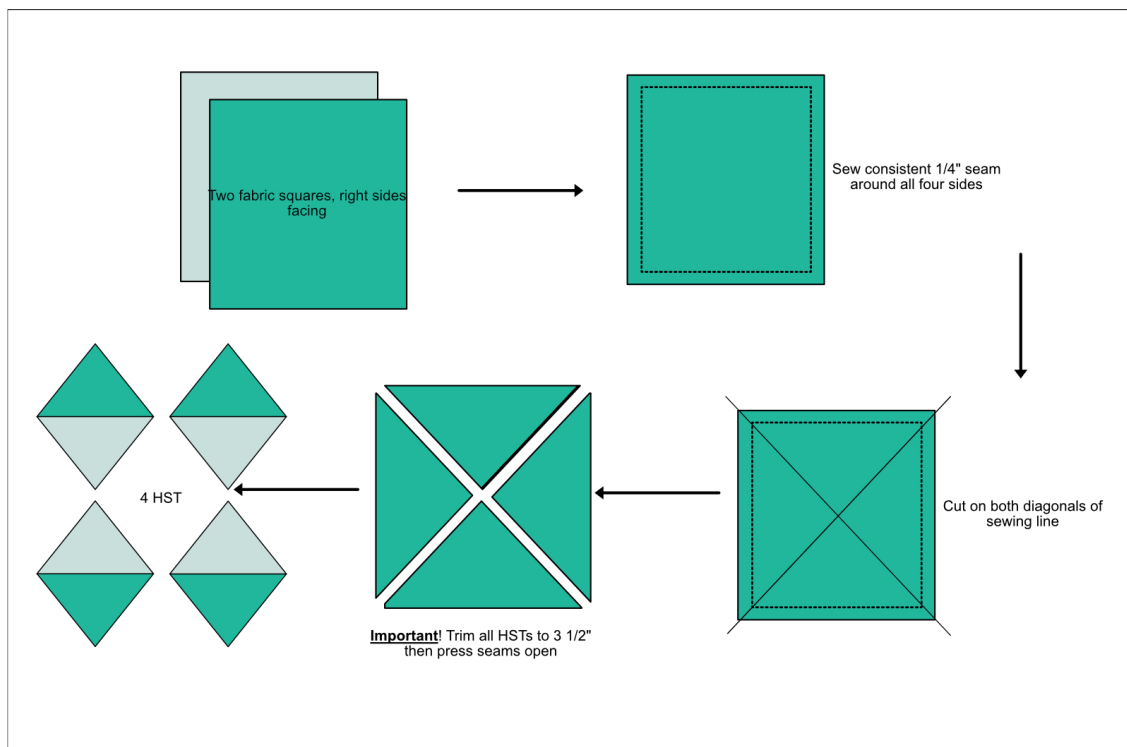
Cut into:

1 x 4 at a time HST using 6” starting squares in background and main colours.

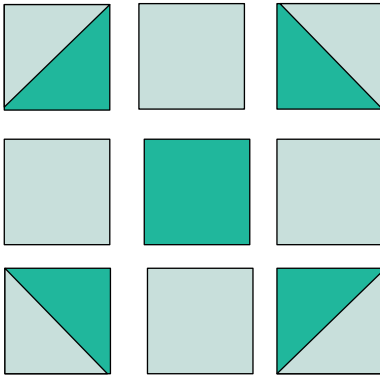
4 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” squares in background colour.

1 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” square in main or contrast colour.

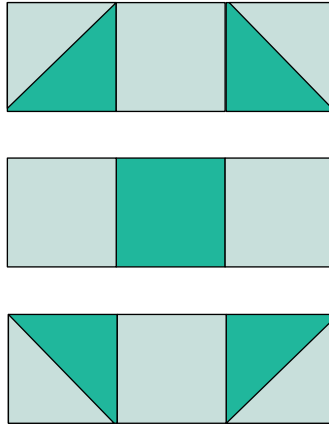
Make 1 x 4 at a time HST set



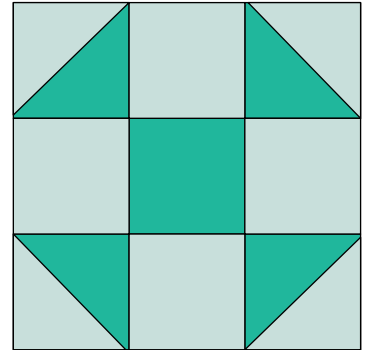
Layout the squares with the HSTs



Sew blocks together by row using 1/4" seam, press seams open

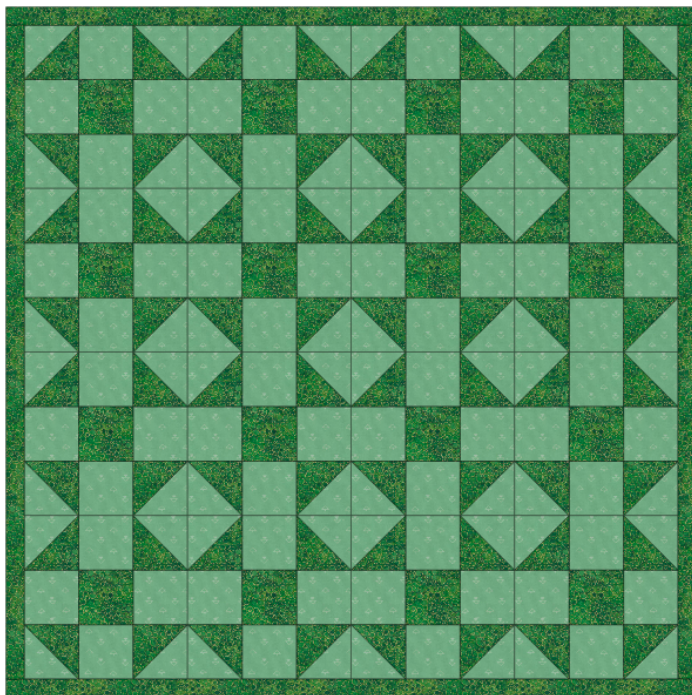


Sew rows together using 1/4" seam, press seams open.



Possible Quilt Layouts

The "Shoofly" block can stand alone, however it is very versatile and plays nicely with other blocks.



Plays very well with other blocks like "a Basic Nine Patch" or "a Nine Patch Snowball Variation"
