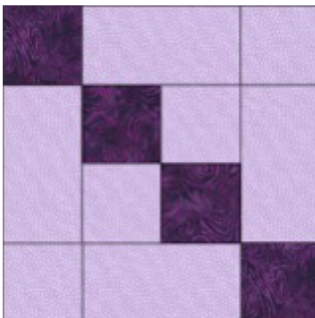


The Block : “Frayed Four Patch”

12” finished - 12 1/2” unfinished



The Requirements:

2 or 3 colours of fabric - 1 Main colour, 1 contrast and 1 Light Background colour.

This block's appearance is very dependent on how many colours you use.

The top picture uses three colours

The bottom picture only two colours.

We will go with the top picture of 3 colours

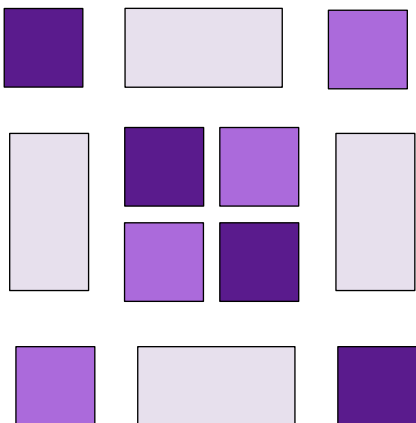
You need:

4 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” squares in the main colour

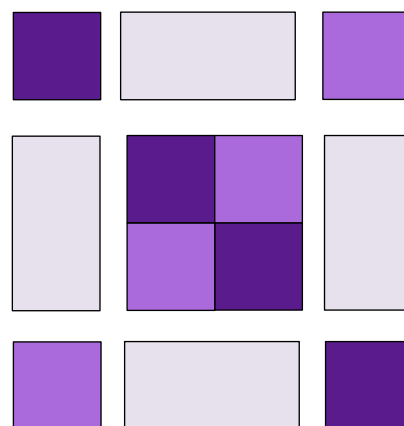
4 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” squares in the contrast colour

4 x 3 1/2” x 6 1/2” rectangles in the background colour

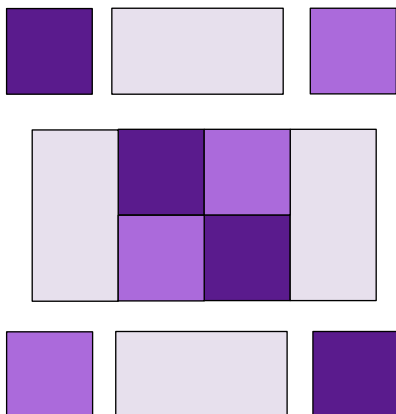
Layout the squares with the rectangles



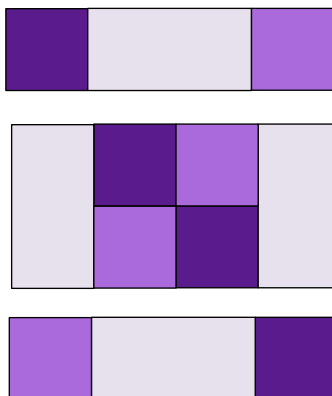
Sew centre block together using 1/4” seam, press seams open



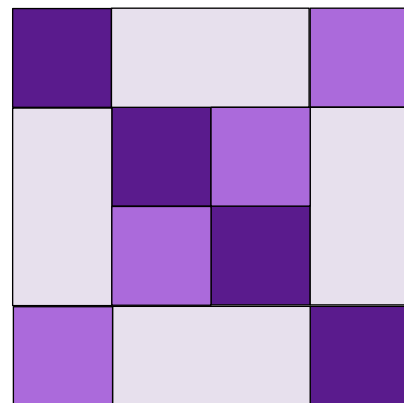
Sew the two outside rectangles to the centre block



Sew top and bottom rows together using 1/4" seam, press seams

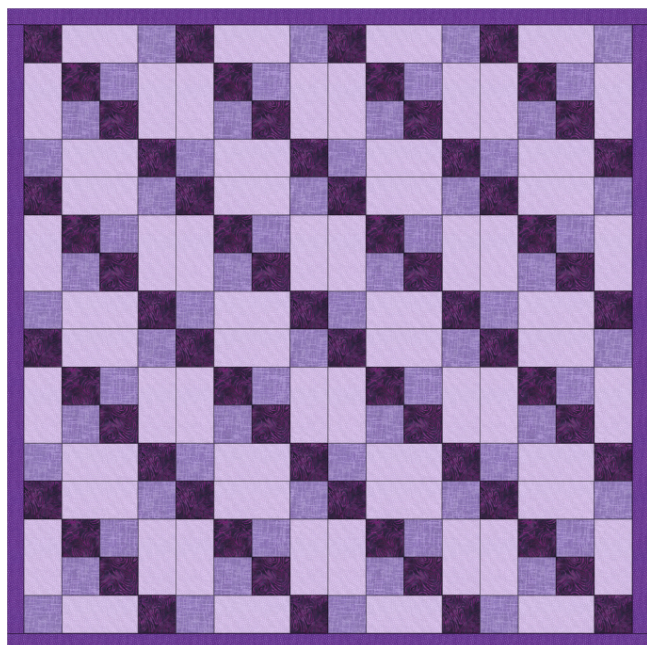


Sew rows to centre block, using 1/4" seam, press seams open.



Possible Quilt Layouts

The "Frayed Four Patch" block can stand alone with some blocks rotated, but I think needs to play with other blocks.....



Plays very well with other blocks like "Grandmother's Picture"
