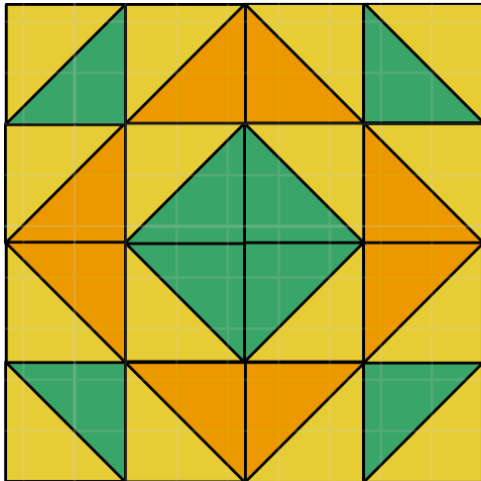


The Block : “Grandmother’s Picture”

12” finished - 12 1/2” unfinished



The Requirements:

3 colours of fabric - 1 Main colour, 1 contrast and 1 Light Background colour.

This block is all HSTs.

For a 12” block (finished) the HST size is 3” (finished) and 3 1/2” unfinished.

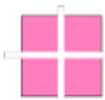
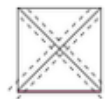
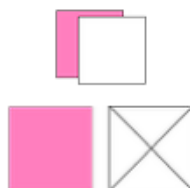
The starting size of the HST square is 8 1/2”

Cut 1 x 8 1/2” x 8 1/2” squares of each of the main and contrast colours

Cut 2 x 8 1/2” x 8 1/2” square of the background colour

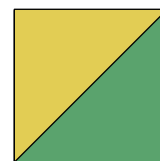
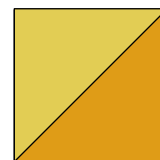
Method:

1. Take 2 squares, one of background and one of colour of required starting size.
2. On the wrong side of the background fabric, draw diagonal lines.
3. With the right sides facing, sew a 1/4” seam down each side of the diagonals.
4. Cut through the centre vertically then horizontally.
5. Then cut on the diagonals to make 8 HSTs.
6. Trim to required size using a triangular trimmer.
7. Open seams and press flat.



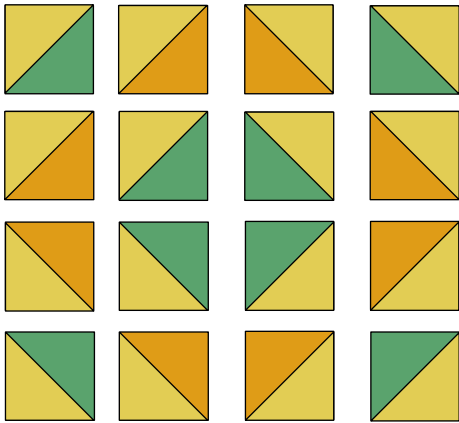

Make the HST set of 8 using the Easy 8 Method (8 of each colour is needed)

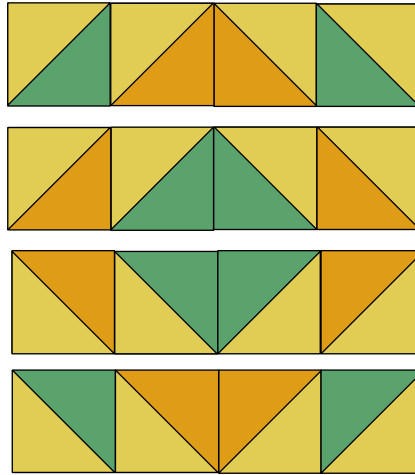


*If you have missed step 6 and have pressed seams open, trim using a block loc or squaring tool of the unfinished size required in the pattern. Bloc Loc squaring tools come in various sizes to match the size of the HST required.

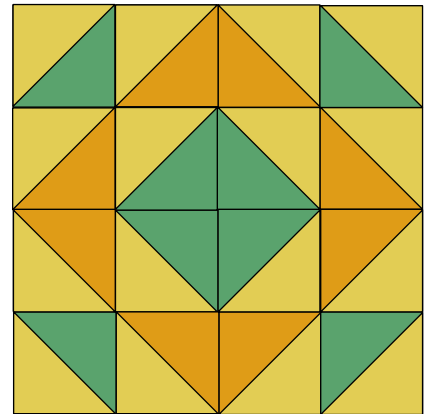
Layout the squares with the
HSTs



Sew blocks together
by row using 1/4"
seam, press seams
open

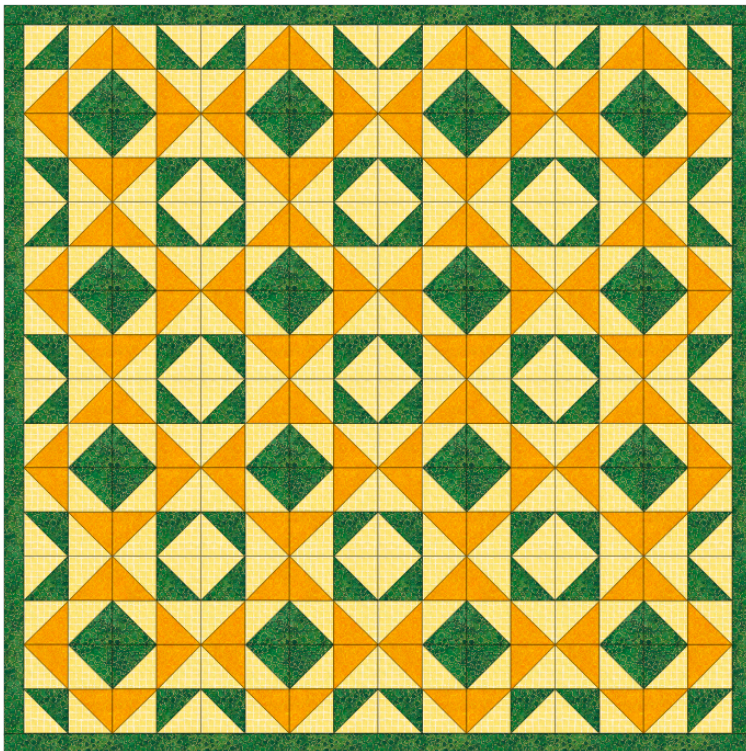


Sew rows together using
1/4" seam, press seams
open.
