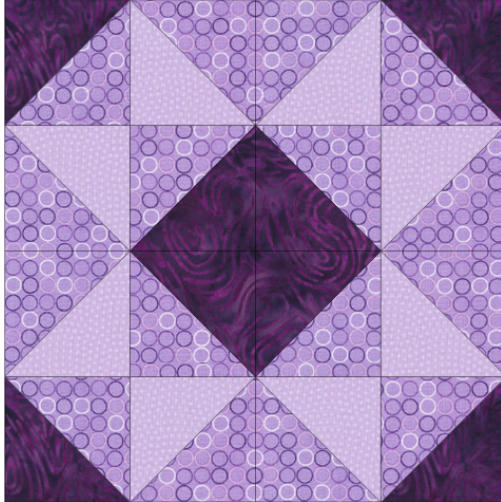


The Block : "Mosaic No 19"

12" finished - 12 1/2" unfinished



The Requirements:

3 colours of fabric - Centred square colour and Background colour, plus 1 contrasts.

Cut into:

1 x 8 at a time HST using 8" starting squares in one contrast colour and the background colour.

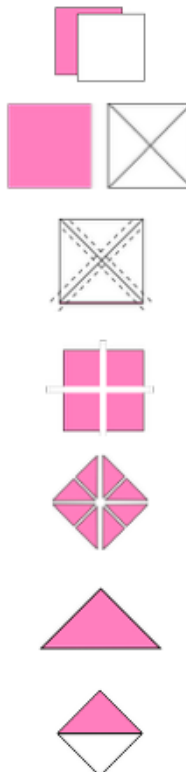
1 x 8 at a time HST using 8" starting squares in one contrast colour and the centre square colour.

16 HST needed.

Method:

1. Take 2 squares, one of background and one of colour of required starting size.
2. On the wrong side of the background fabric, draw diagonal lines.
3. With the right sides facing, sew a 1/4" seam down each side of the diagonals.
4. Cut through the centre vertically then horizontally.
5. Then cut on the diagonals to make 8 HSTs.
6. Trim to required size using a triangular trimmer.
7. Open seams and press flat.

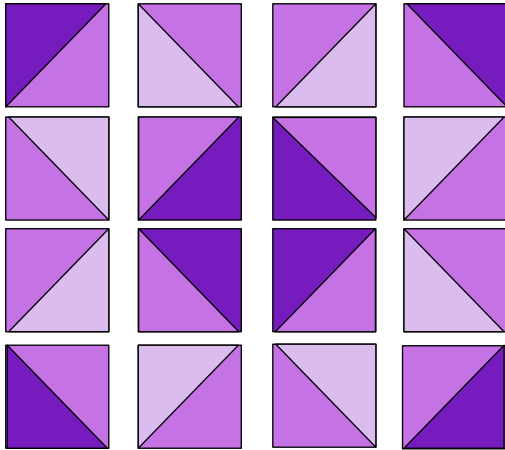
Make 1 set of Easy 8

square colour.

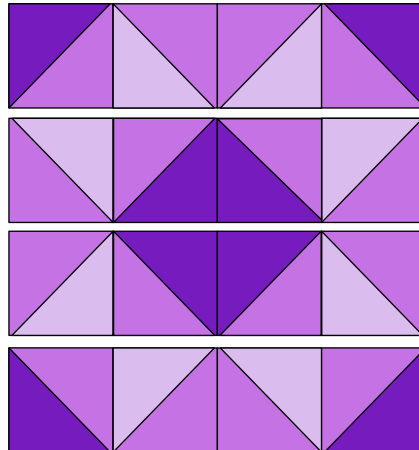
16 HST needed

*If you have missed step 6 and have pressed seams open, trim using a block loc or squaring tool of the unfinished size required in the pattern. Bloc Loc squaring tools come in various sizes to match the size of the HST required.

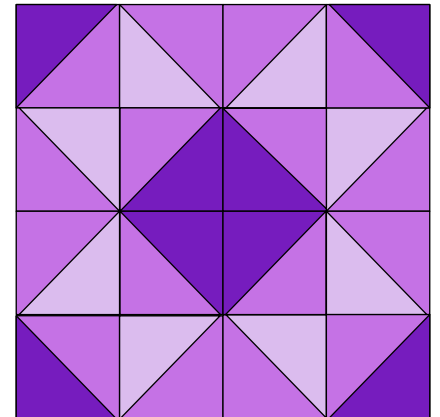
Layout the squares with the
HSTs

by row using 1/4"
seam, press seams
open

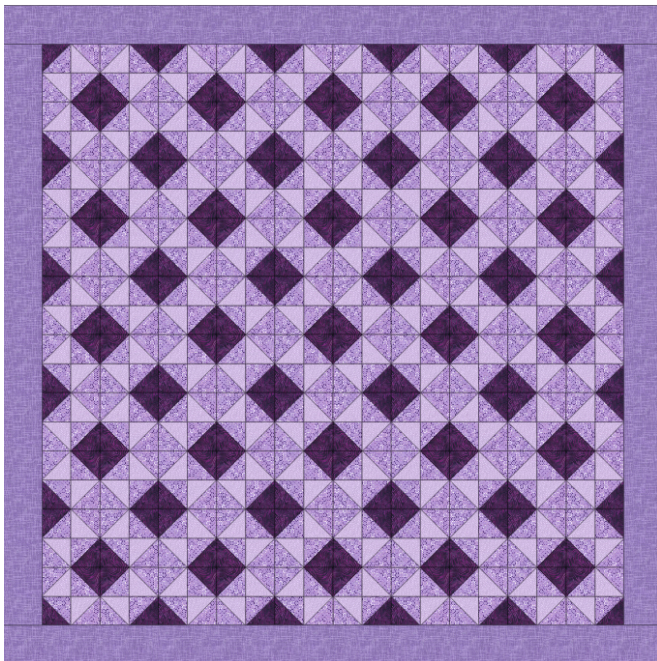


Sew rows together using
