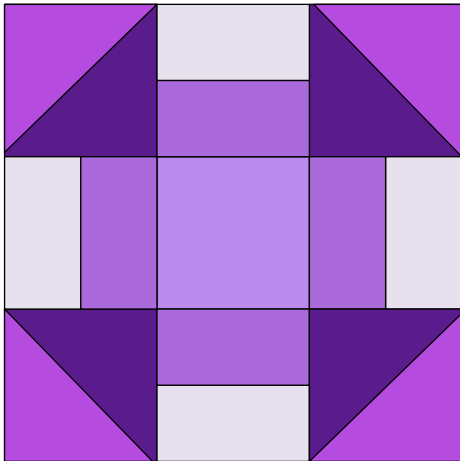


The Block : “Churn Dash”

9” finished - 9 1/2” unfinished



The Requirements:

5 colours of fabric - Centred square colour and Background colour, plus 3 contrasts.

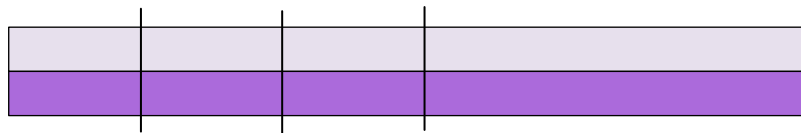
Cut into:

1 x 4 at a time HST using 6” starting squares in two contrast colours.

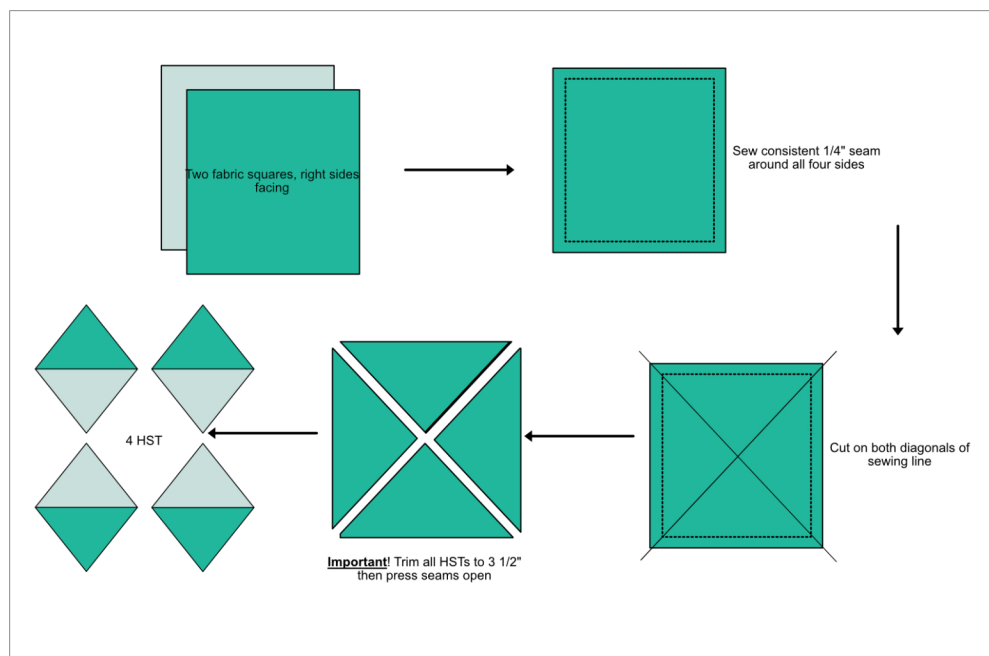
4 x 3 1/2” x 2” rectangles in background and 3rd contrast colour. (alternative is to create a strip using 2” strips of 3rd contrast and background, subcut into 3 1/2” squares)

1 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” square in centre square colour.

Strip set - sew 1 x 2” x WOF of each background and 3rd contrast together.

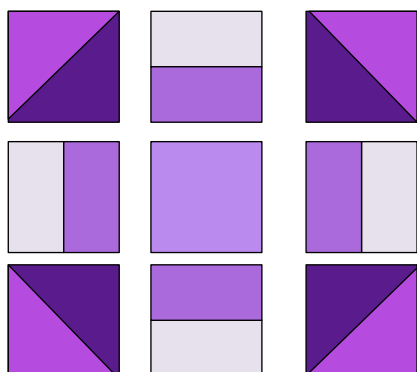


Sub cut into 3 1/2” squares

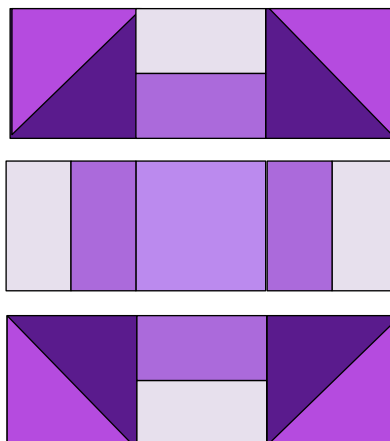


Make 1 x 4 at a time HST set using the two contrast colours

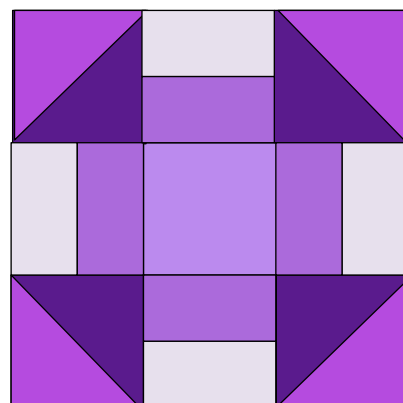
Layout the squares with the HSTs



Sew blocks together by row using 1/4" seam, press seams open

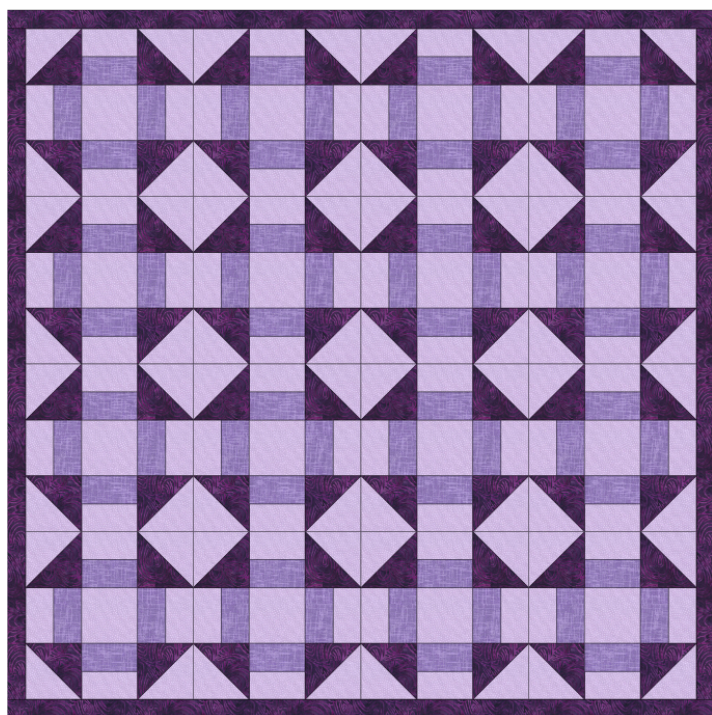


Sew rows together using 1/4" seam, press seams open.



Possible Quilt Layouts

The "Churn Dash" block can stand alone, however it is very versatile and plays nicely with other blocks.



Plays very well with other blocks like "Shoofly" or "Friendship Star"
