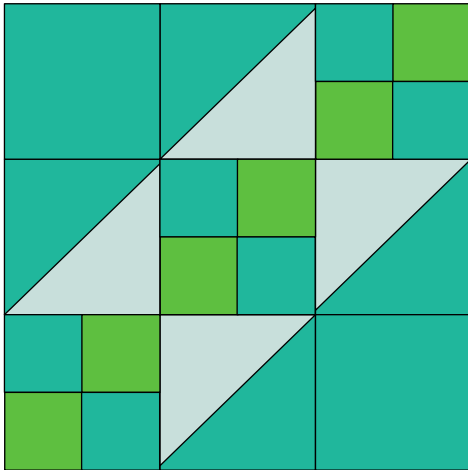


The Block : “Rocky Road to California”

12” finished - 12 1/2” unfinished



The Requirements:

3 colours of fabric - Main, Contrast colour and Background colour.

Cut into:

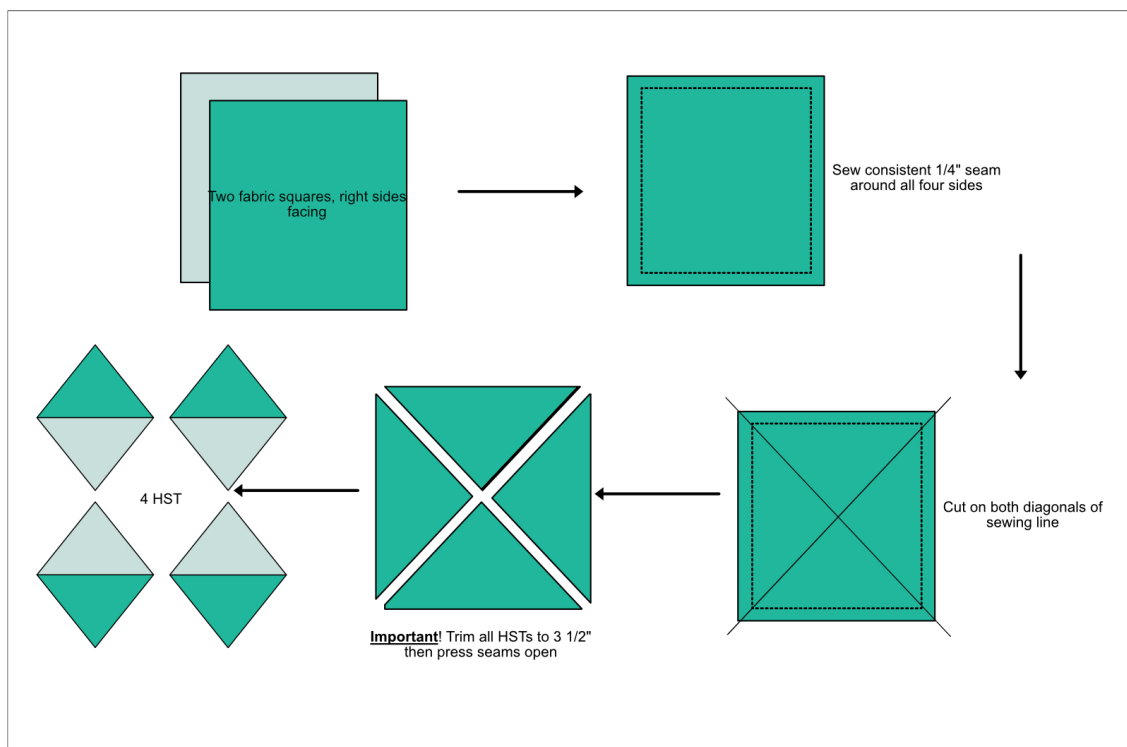
1 x 4 at a time HST using 7 1/2” starting squares in background and main colours.

6 x 2 1/2” x 2 1/2” squares in contrast colour.

6 x 2 1/2” x 2 1/2” squares in main colour.

2 x 4 1/2” x 4 1/2” squares in main colour

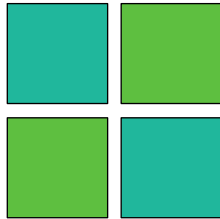
Make 1 x 4 at a time HST set



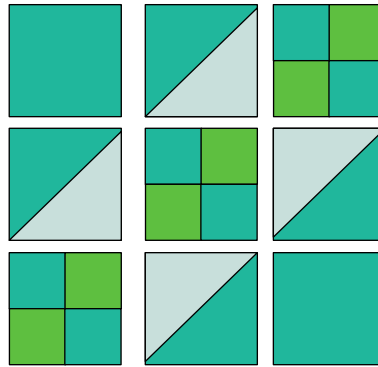
Size of block can vary depending on requirements.

The HST starting square can be calculated to suit. Check Free HST sizing charts for measurements.

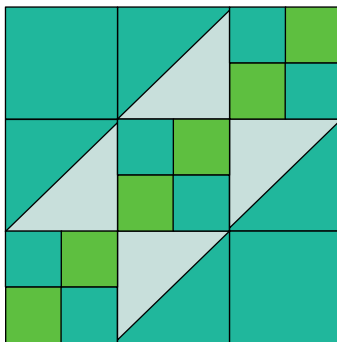
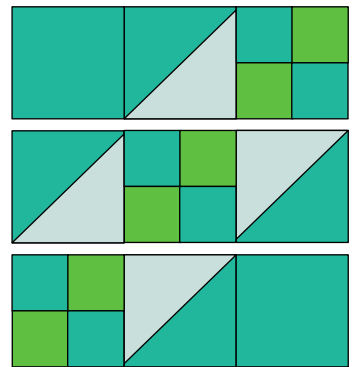
Sew 2 1/2" square together using 1/4" seam, press seams open. Make 3 sets



Layout the squares with the HSTs



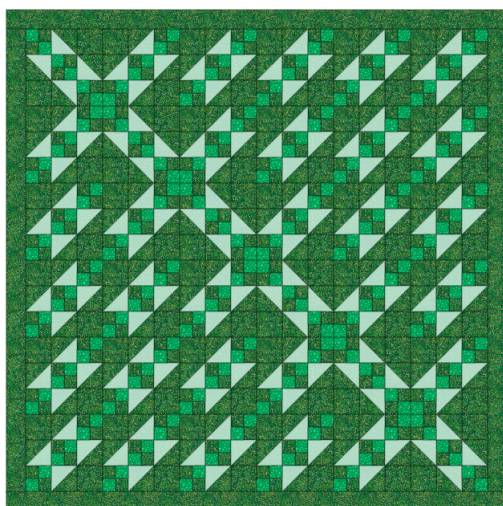
Sew sub blocks together by row, using 1/4" seam, press seams open.



Sew rows together, using 1/4" seam, press seams open.

Possible Quilt Layout

The "Rocky Road to California" block can stand alone, however it is very versatile and plays nicely with other blocks.



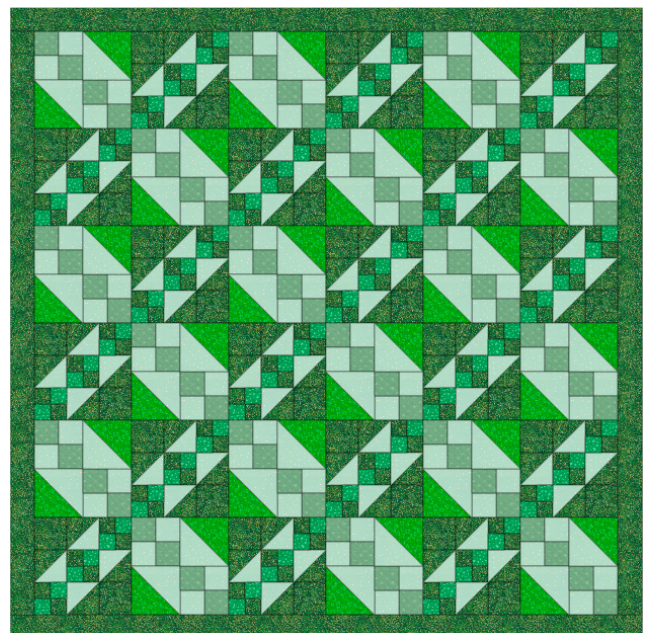
78" x 78" including 3" border
