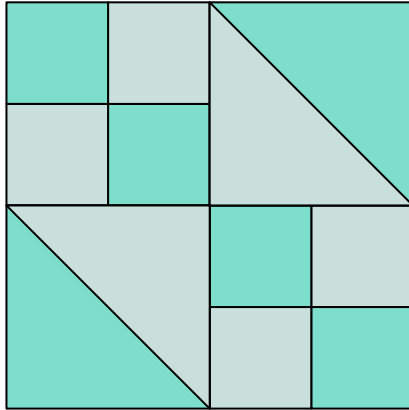


The Block : “Hour Glass Variation”

12” finished - 12 1/2” unfinished



The Requirements:

2 colours of fabric - Main colour and Background colour.

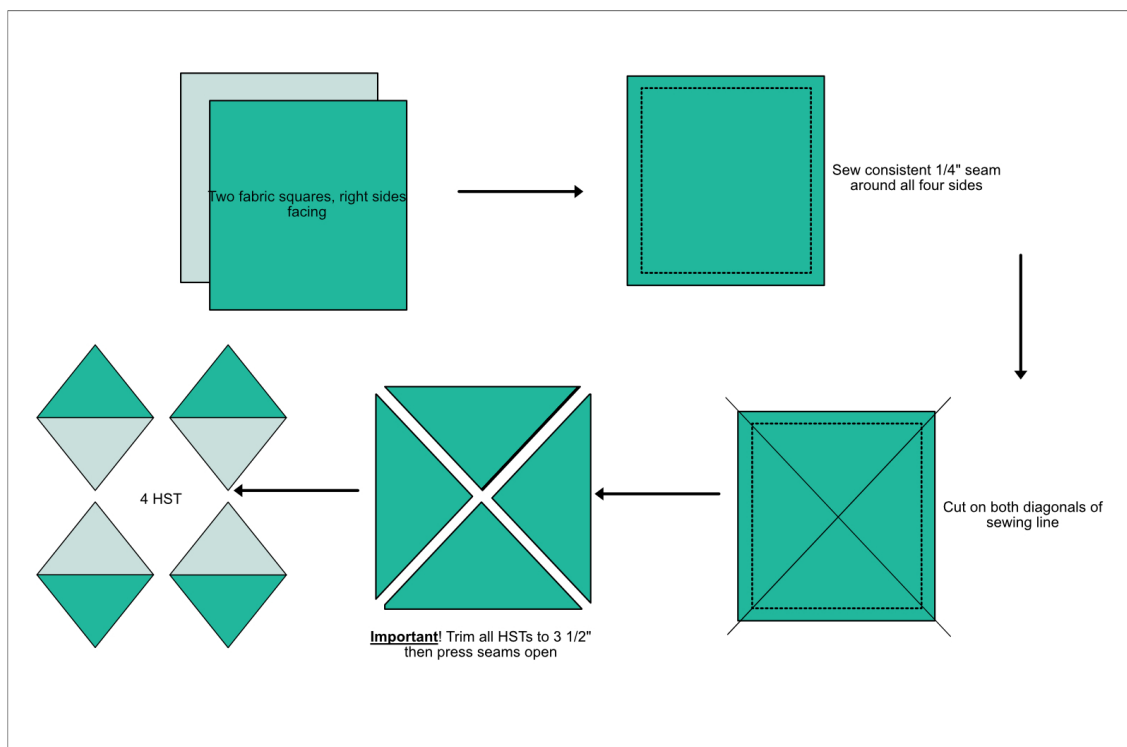
Cut into:

1 x 4 at a time HST using 10 1/2” starting squares in background and main colours (there will be enough here for two blocks).

4 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” squares in background colour.

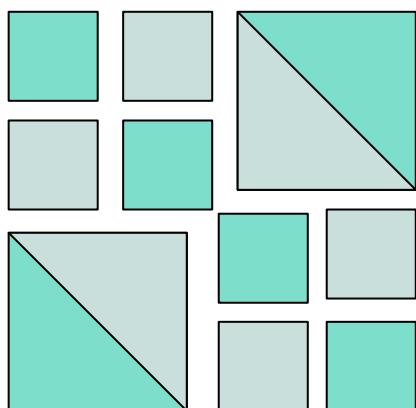
4 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” square in main colour.

Make 1 x 4 at a time HST set

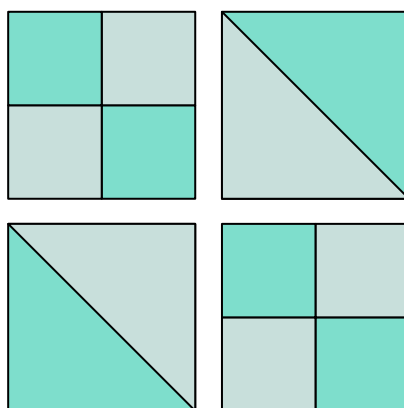


Size of block can vary depending on requirements. Any multiple of 3 will work. The HST starting square can be calculated to suit. Check Free HST sizing charts for measurements.

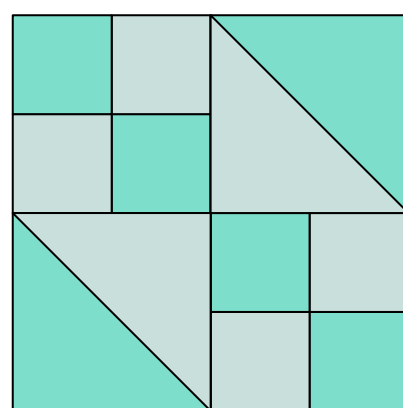
Layout the squares with the HSTs



Sew 3 1/2" square together using 1/4" seam, press seams open.

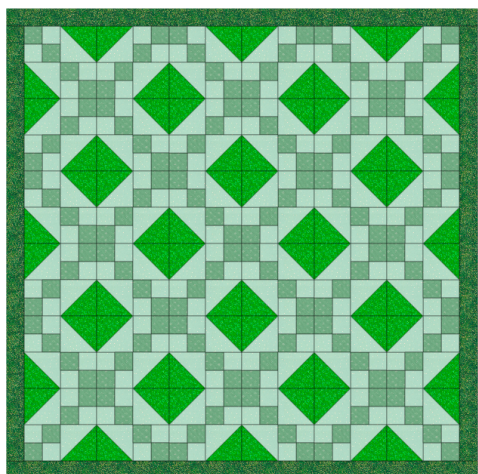


Sew sub blocks together using 1/4" seam, press seams open.



Possible Quilt Layout

The "Hour Glass Variation" block can stand alone, however it is very versatile and plays nicely with other blocks.



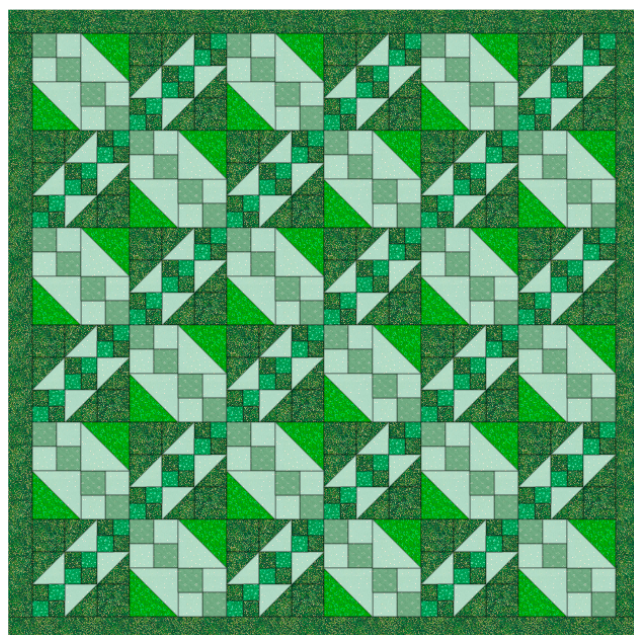
78" x 78" including 3" border

1 1/2 yds/metres of 3 others including border
