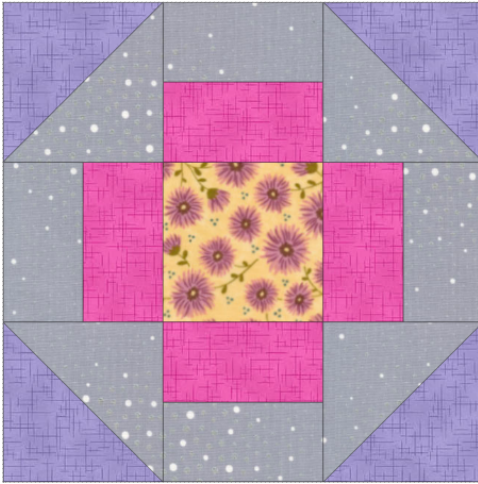


The Block : “Greek Cross”

9” finished - 9 1/2” unfinished



The Requirements:

4 colours of fabric - Centred square colour and Background colour, plus 2 contrasts.

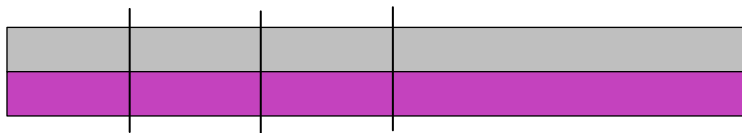
Cut into:

1 x 4 at a time HST using 6” starting squares in one contrast colour and the background colour.

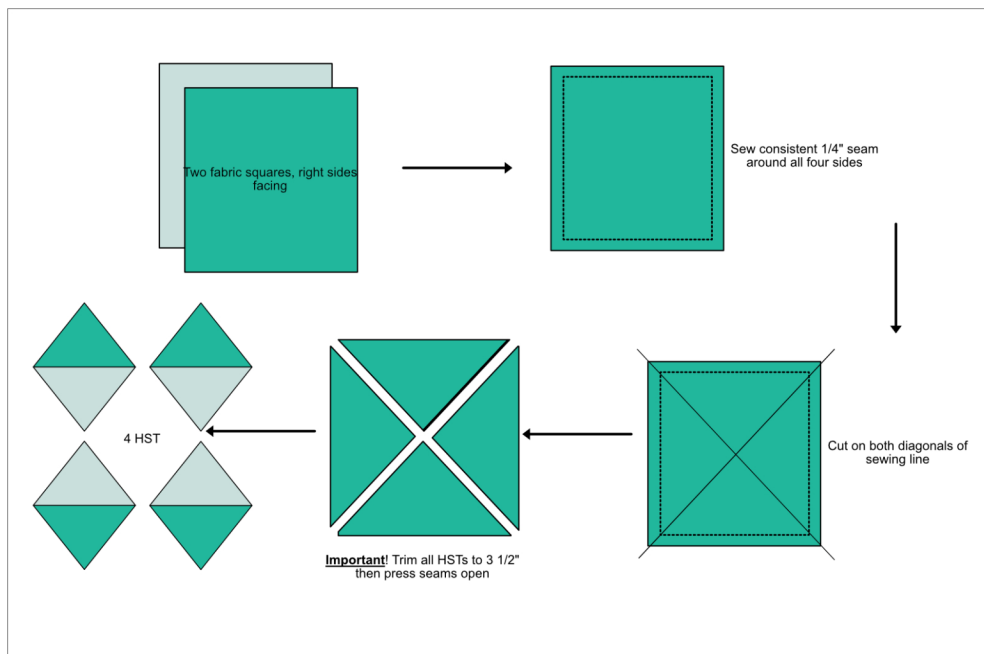
4 x 3 1/2” x 2” rectangles in the two contrast colours.
(alternative is to create a strip using 2” strips of 3rd contrast and background, subcut into 3 1/2” squares)

1 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” square in centre square colour.

Strip set - sew 1 x 2” x WOF of each of the contrast colours.

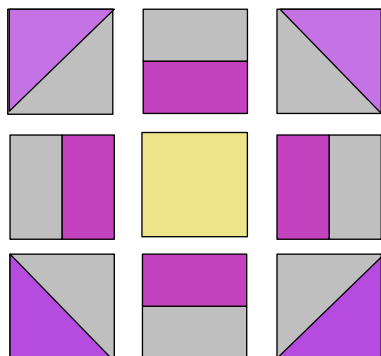


Sub cut into 3 1/2” squares

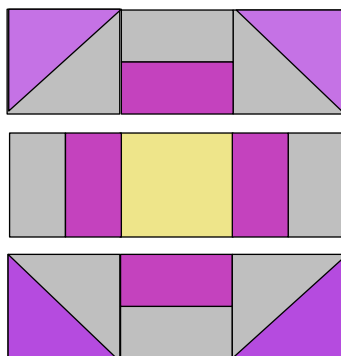


Make 1 x 4 at a time HST set using the one contrast colour and the background colour

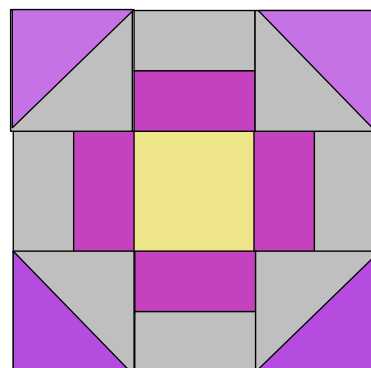
Layout the squares with the HSTs



Sew blocks together by row using 1/4" seam, press seams open



Sew rows together using 1/4" seam, press seams open.



You have probably worked out by now that the "Greek Cross" is the same as the "Churn Dash".....the way the colours are laid out is what makes this block.

Possible Quilt Layouts

The "Greek Cross" block can stand alone, however it is very versatile and plays nicely with other blocks.

Plays very well with other blocks like "Shoofly"
