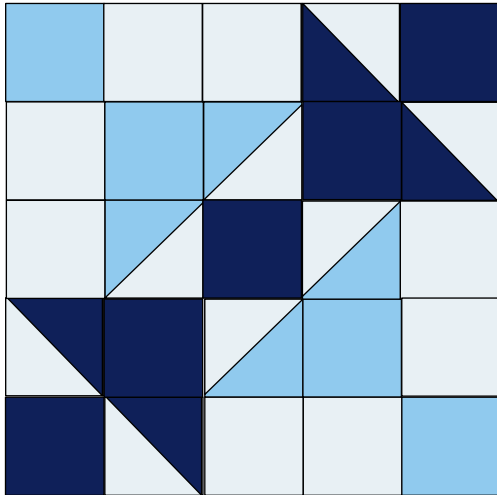


The Block : “Grandmother’s Puzzle”

15” finished - 15 1/2” unfinished



The Requirements:

3 colours of fabric - 1 Dark Main, 1 Medium Contrast colour and 1 Light Background colour.

Cut into:

1 x 4 at a time HST using 6” starting squares in the Medium Contrast and Light Background.

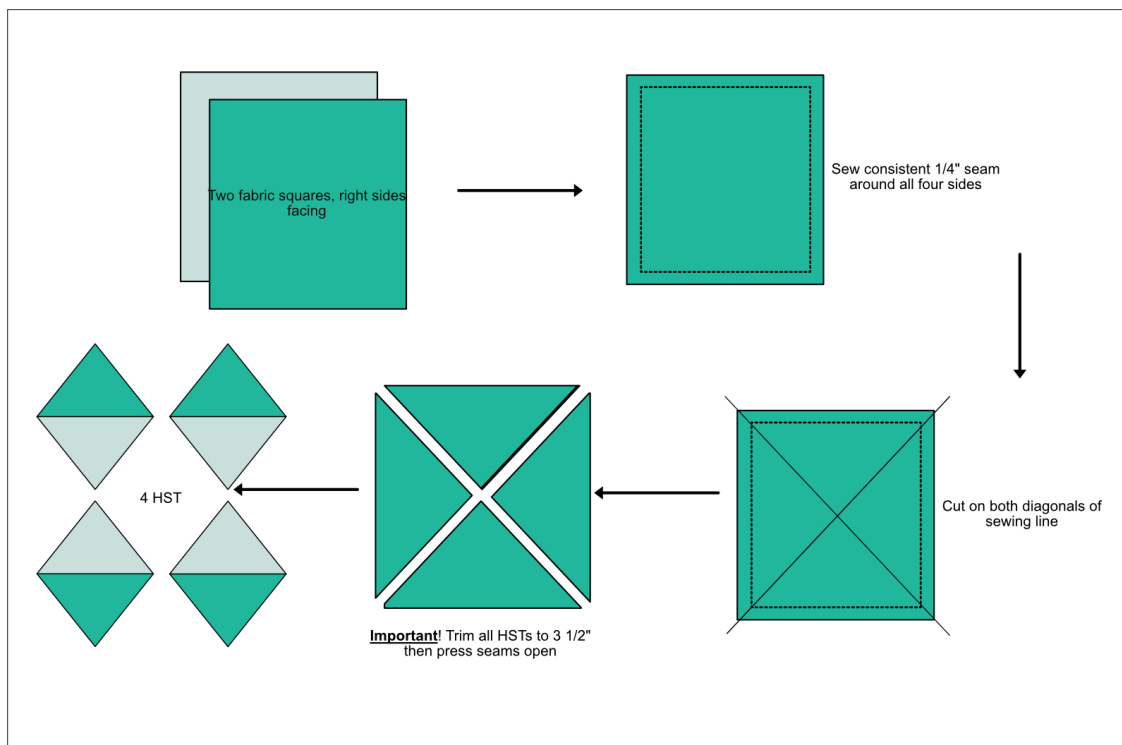
1 x 4 at a time HST using 6” starting squares in the Dark Main and Light Background colours.

8 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” in the Light Background colour.

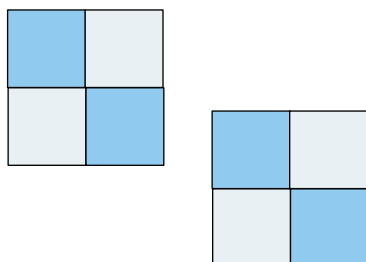
5 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” squares in the Dark Main colour.

4 x 3 1/2” x 3 1/2” squares in the Medium Contrast colour.

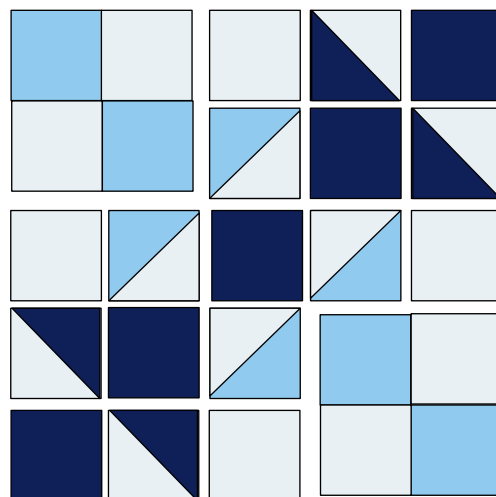
Make the HST sets



1. Sew 3 1/2" squares together using 1/4" seam, press seams open.



2. Layout the remaining squares with the HSTs



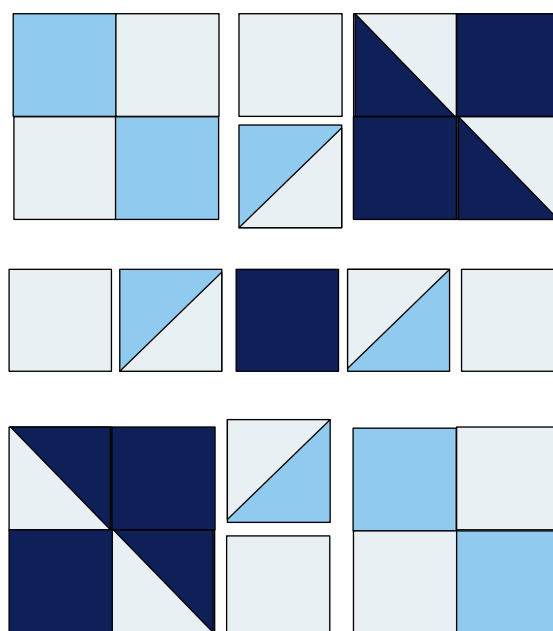
3. Split the block into 3 sections

Top 2 rows - sew dark squares together, then add the rest

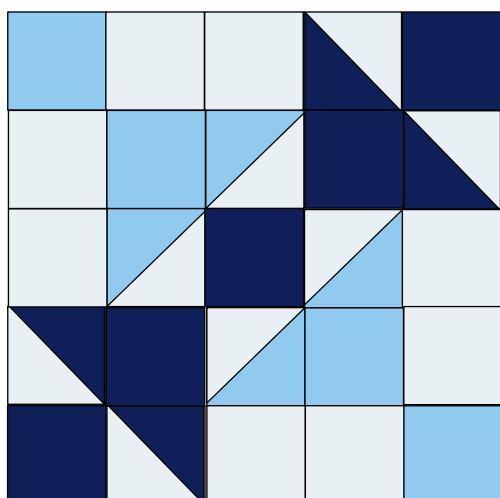
Middle row - sew as a row from left to right

Bottom 2 rows - sew dark squares together, then add the rest

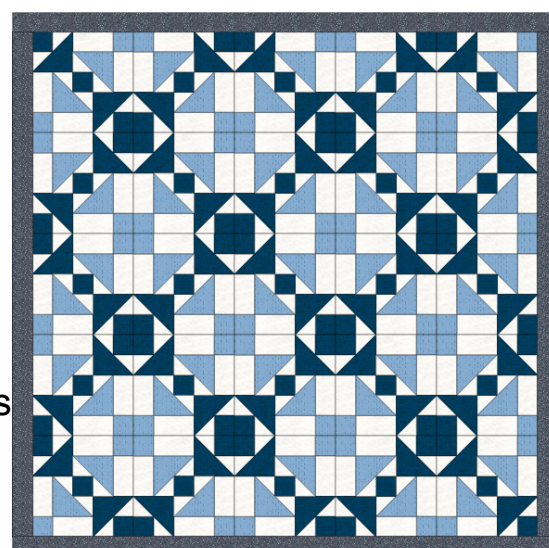
Always use 1/4" seams and press open.



4. Sew the three sections together, using 1/4" seam, press seams open.



Possible Quilt Layout



The "Grandmother's Puzzle" block can stand alone.
